Interstate 10: Picacho Peak Road to Pinal Air Park Road
Traffic Alert for Nov. 16 – 20, 2009

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is scheduling the following restrictions as part of the Interstate 10 widening between Picacho Peak Road and Pinal Air Park Road. Please note that traffic control devices may be set up early, but restrictions will occur as scheduled.

Expect slowing in the construction zone, and workers will be present on the roadway. Motorists are advised to please be alert to the speed limit and posted signs while driving through the construction zone.

East- and Westbound I-10

- From 8 p.m. through 6 a.m. the following morning, from Monday, Nov. 16 through Thursday, Nov. 19, east- and westbound I-10 from Picacho Peak Road (milepost 218) to Pinal Air Park Road (milepost 232) is scheduled for rolling lane restrictions as construction workers install raised pavement markers on the roadway. Two lanes of traffic will remain open at all times.

Please note: Changes to construction plans can happen frequently due to weather, equipment availability and personnel issues. We try to anticipate construction activities a week in advance, but changes may occur. Intermittent lane closures, with short delays, may not always be known in advance.
