#### Interstate 10 Widening Closures

The Arizona Department of Transportation is scheduling the following closures as part of the Interstate 10 widening project from Prince Road to 29th Street. Please note that this schedule is subject to change in order to accommodate the project's accelerated schedule. Access to the businesses and residences will remain open.

#### **I-10 WILL NOT BE CLOSED.**

ADOT appreciates your patience and your continued cooperation while we work to improve I-10. Due to the high impact on traffic during this time, please obey all posted speed limit signs and detour routes while driving through the construction zone and remain alert for construction personnel, equipment and Department of Public Safety officials.

#### **Westbound I-10**

The westbound I-10 exit ramp at 22nd/29th Street is scheduled to be closed overnight from Sunday, April 1, 2007, at 11:00 p.m. to Monday, April 2, 2007, at 5:00 a.m.

#### **Southbound I-19**

The southbound I-19 entrance ramp at 29th Street is scheduled to be closed overnight from Monday, April 2, 2007, at 11:00 p.m. to Tuesday, April 3, 2007, at 5:00 a.m.

#### **Eastbound Frontage Road**

The right lane of the eastbound I-10 frontage road at Fort Lowell Road continues to be closed for approximately four more weeks.

Intermittent lane closures on the eastbound I-10 frontage road between Congress Street and Granada Avenue/Clark Street continue for approximately four more weeks.

### Westbound Frontage Road

The right lane on the I-10 westbound frontage road from Speedway Boulevard to Congress Street will have intermittent closures beginning Monday, April 2, 2007, for approximately three weeks.

The left lane on the I-10 westbound frontage road from 1,000 feet north of Granada Avenue/Clark Street to 500 feet south of Granada Avenue/Clark Street continues to be closed for approximately four more weeks.

Intermittent lanes closures continue on the I-10 westbound frontage road from Congress Street to 22nd Street.

### West Fort Lowell Road

Access remains restricted on West Fort Lowell Road west of I-10 between the eastbound frontage road and La Cholla Boulevard and will continue for approximately four more weeks.

### Prince Road

On Wednesday, April 4, 2007, Prince Road is scheduled to be closed between the I-10 westbound frontage road and west of I-10 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

### Grant Road

On Tuesday, April 3, 2007, from 4:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., the right turn lane on eastbound Grant Road approaching the eastbound frontage road is scheduled to be closed. In addition, the right lane on eastbound Grant Road under the bridge is also scheduled to be closed. Alternating lane closures on Grant Road will also occur while crews perform survey work for the new waterline. A DPS officer will be on site to direct traffic.

On Friday, April 6, 2007, intermittent lanes closures on eastbound Grant Road under I-10 are scheduled to occur for one day beginning at 9 a.m. for saw-cutting operations.
